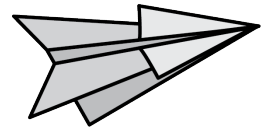

LAST MONTH

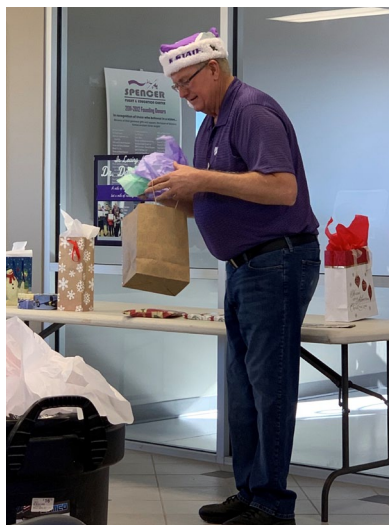
FROM RANDAL LODER

DIRECTIONS FOR DRIVE-INS: KHQG is located SE of the intersection of Hwy 56 and Road 11, 2 miles southwest of the city.

Runways:

02/20: 5000x75’ concrete and **13/31** 2627x60’ asphalt
Noise abatement: Aircraft avoid climbout over city at all times

CT 122.8 and Weather 118.6T or 620-544-4000

Caution: Runway 13/31 has cracks in the surface that are in the process of being repaired. Small wheeled aircraft should use caution. (Most likely this will NOT be the active runway)
